Please find below the latest news summary of some of the crime which has occurred in the above areas over the past month. In the month of July there have been 12 incidents which have been classified as crimes by the home office.

Burglaries (3)

We have had 1 dwelling burglary and 1 Non-Dwelling burglaries reported this month. Let's ensure we keep our property well secured especially as the festive season is now upon us!

- Penwood, A house was broken into and items stolen from within. Suspect has been arrested
- Penwood, A garage has been forced open and gardening equipment stolen (not linked to above incident)
- Penwood. Shed has been broken into and gardening equipment stolen

Please keep this information in mind whilst protecting your premises/property:

- Use timer switches (available from most D.I.Y stores) to switch on lights, radios while you are away from the home to make it look and sound occupied.
- Ensure you shut and lock windows and doors when you return home and settle down for the evening.
- Ensure you have used padlocks on the side gates to deny access to the rear of the property.
- Ensure your outside lighting is in working order (consider low level ambient light on a dusk to dawn sensor) this will activate even when you are not at home.

Criminal Damage (1)

- Old Burgclere, Green Subaru Legacy containing 4/5 males seen hare coursing and driving at speed across a wheat field causing damage to the crop

Please consider installing CCTV to protect your property.

Theft from Vehicle (1)

- A34 layby Tothill Services, Diesel siphoned out of aggrieved vehicle as he slept overnight in his vehicle.

Public Order (3)

- St Mary Bourne, Drunken male has been verbally abusive to a couple out walking. Suspect identified and spoken to
- St Mary Bourne, A man has become verbally abusive towards a female in the local pub. Investigations ongoing.
- Lady walking her dog in Penwood woods has been threatened with violence towards her and her dog by a male

Assault (2)

- Burghclere, Aggrieved has reported being bitten by a dog while out running
- Penwood, Argument between siblings has resulted in a tablet becoming damaged

Theft of Vehicle (2)

- Bishops Green, vehicle later recovered by Officers from another County
- Highclere, Theft of a Land Rover later recovered and returned to owners
